

The Australian National Day of Prayer for Defence turns 10 this year. It encourages all Christians who have a heart to pray for Defence to join together in uplifting the Australian Defence Organisation to God.

Groups across Australia will pray either on the day or generally in the week preceding. Churches are welcome to host an event. People of other faiths are welcome to attend.

Closer to the date there will be a downloadable prayer booklet – this can be adapted to your local setting. It includes prayer for deployed personnel, those who have returned with physical, mental and spiritual injuries, defence leadership and culture, amongst other things.

Organise a group to pray – It can be as simple as adding prayer points to your regular Small Group meeting, having your Church have special prayers on the Sunday and/or recognise and pray for any Defence members/families in the congregation, host a special prayer meeting at home or work. You don't need to be part of Defence to be involved.
