For the Bible is a collection of books and letters written over a long period of time by many different people of various backgrounds. In it is the revealed truth of God – Jesus Christ. It contains historical accounts, prophecy, wisdom, practical guidance and most importantly salvation. By understanding who God is and who he has created us to be we can be set free from bondage, restored from exile, and we can find hope and purpose for our lives.



The ADF Daily Devotional has been compiled by many Chaplains across the three services and journeys through the Bible in a way that helps make sense of it all. There's even devotionals that deal with military issues. In short, it is written for you, our ADF members along with your families! While the Devotional is available in hard copy from your local Chaplain or the MCF office, if you are unable to get to a Chaplain, or are stuck in

lockdown, the *Devotional is being re-produced as a YouTube based podcast*. (Not DPN) Each Devotion is 3-4 minutes, often being read by the person who wrote it.
