During the recent Anzac day commemorations we again reflected on the considerable cost of war both in terms of human lives lost and the long-term impact on those remaining. This year it seems particularly poignant as we see images from the war in Ukraine splashed across our screens on the evening news. Contemporary images again depicting the loss, destruction and associated grief. We also hear reports of tensions rising closer to home in our own region. These things can easily unsettle us and even drive us to despair. But what should the believer's response be to these things?



Jesus instructed his disciples in Matt 24:6 "You will hear of wars and rumours of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come." (NIV)

Jesus warned his followers that these things would come, but that we should not be alarmed as if these things are a surprise to God. Unpleasant as it may be, it is all part of God's plan for his world and so we can take comfort that all things are still under his control. Events are unfolding exactly as predicted.

Certainly, we are not called to a life of apathy or indifference. We should absolutely do all in our power to avoid conflict and alleviate suffering. Jesus' earthly ministry was characterised by his concern for those in need, and so should ours as we walk in his footsteps (though our ability to make the lame walk and give the blind their sight might be limited).

Jesus goes on in Matt 24:8 "All these are the beginning of birth pains." (NIV) These are the struggles and hardships that will usher in the new world when Christ returns; one that is free of hardship, suffering and death for all who put their trust in Jesus. And that is the promise we are called to proclaim. Rejoice in this hope.
