What do FCMM partners FOCUS and Navs do?

"Did you bake all this?" Was the incredulous question from a number of first year trainee officers at ADFA

as they were presented with an incredible range of home baked goods for supper after their first military chapel service.

Each year the chapel services during the Year One Familiarisation Training (YOFT) are a highlight for many trainees during the intensity of their first weeks at ADFA. A chance to just breathe, and the first hit of sugar they've had since day 1.

The chaplains run the service itself, creating a beautiful space for rest and reflection for everyone, regardless of their faith background. Then after the service the trainees mill around outside the Duntroon Chapel, chatting over the supper that has been provided by volunteers from Navigators, FOCUS and local churches, while the Salvos provide drinks.

Volunteers and staff from Navigators and FOCUS wander around chatting to trainees and collecting details for anyone who's interested in receiving information about

the groups so that we can invite them along to socials, bible studies, and other events once semester starts.

While FOCUS and Navigatorss at ADFA have varied ministry approaches and styles, both ministries are united in the centrality of the gospel - that makes for a great partnership! As the academic semester gets going at the beginning of March, both groups will run activities to build community, help Christians grow in faith, and for anyone who's interested to explore faith and consider the claims of Christianity. Navigators and FOCUS staff support trainee officers who coordinate activities for the groups as part of the voluntary extra-curricular clubs at ADFA. Both groups are committed to providing every trainee with the opportunity to know Jesus, and to grow or explore faith as young adults within a military context.

Trainee officers regularly testify to the blessing of being part of vibrant Christian community during their time at ADFA. We expect, hope and pray that 2023 will be another year of God working through the ministry of FOCUS and Navigators to bless trainees through reading the Bible and talking about faith with mentors and peers, training in Christ-like leadership, and the support and warmth of Christian community.

Please be praying for Christians to connect well with Christian community on and off base and to grow in faith.

Please also pray for anyone thinking about faith and exploring Christianity too understand the truth of the gospel.

Navigators and particularly FOCUS also have ministry opportunities on other Bases, primarily at ADF training facilities. Please also remember these in prayer.
