

Remembering Sacrifice

Dear Brothers and Sisters

Over the last month many Christians have been on a Lenten Pilgrimage starting on Ash Wednesday. This is a most significant time of year for Christians and an important time for us to pause and reflect on what we believe and why we believe it. In the week before Easter, we enter what is traditionally called Holy Week which starts on Palm Sunday and concludes celebrating the Resurrection of Christ and thus the absolute uniqueness and pivotal point of Christianity.

Jesus' death and resurrection is a historical fact, just as ANZAC Day is, however unlike ANZAC Day which commemorates effectively a defeat or a withdrawal, Easter celebrates the most important and substantial victory ever achieved both in heaven and on earth. Both days however remind us of sacrifice and love (agape) of others above self.

Unfortunately, cultural compromise and fear of people's opinions have caused many believers to shy away from Jesus' exclusive claim that He is the only way to Eternal Life, this is not a new phenomenon but one that has occurred from the very start of the church, two millennia ago.



As we move through the Easter Season and celebrate with friends and family it is my prayer that you will be blessed with the boldness and strength to be able to remind people why this is the most significant time of the year for Christians.

But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give a reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect. 1 Peter 3:15

This interesting and thought provoking interview touches on many topics in today's world, including ADF Chaplaincy.



Why not get your MCF group (and their families) together and see one of these?




Now Showing - From the organisation behind The Chosen, Angel Studios is now bringing us a feature film on a Bible story that has never been told before.
