It's the Lord's strategic plan to place you in Defence as His salt and light!



The Lord needs you...rekindle your fire for Him!



What is the Forum of Christian Military Ministries? (FCMM)

The FCMM is made up of the following organisations: Association for Christian Conferences, Teaching and Service (ACCTS), Everymans Welfare Service (EWS), FOCUS Military Ministry (FOCUS), Military Christian Fellowship of Australia (MCF-A), Navigators Military Ministry (Navs), Red Shield Defence Services (RSDS/Sallyman), Solid Rock Ministries. The FCMM is not an umbrella organisation, rather a cooperative arrangement in which the partner organisations commit to pray for and support each other in a spirit of cooperation for the role that each plays in God's Kingdom work in Defence. It enables us to share initiatives, keep abreast of what each other are doing and coordinate efforts where that may provide efficiencies or amplification of effort. There is a Forum of Christian Military Ministries Covenant, which was last signed in August 2016 by the then leads of each organisation.

The covenant reads:

Recognising that all who in Christ are members of the one body, and that our ministries are often co-located, we will make every effort to:

- Love one another
- Pray for one another
- Encourage one another
- Support one another
- Meet with one another
- Communicate with one another

- Coordinate with one another
- Cooperate with one another

In accordance with the scriptures, to the end that Jesus Christ might be glorified.

The FCMM leads meet for a day or two at least once a year and also invite Bible Society Australia and an ADF Chaplaincy Rep to their meetings. Other leads, such as the SW Pacific Association of Military Christian Fellowship (AMCF) lead, and other likeminded groups may also be invited for all or part of the meeting day/s.
