Being Still


Be still before the Lord and wait patiently on Him. Psalm 37:7

Being still seems to be the opposite of what happens in society, as we rush headlong towards Christmas you find people yearning for peace, quietness and being still. These things seem like a mirage or mist that just as you think you can grasp them then you find they just vaporise. When looking at history this is not a new issue.

So what is being still let alone before the Lord?

them to overcome many obstacles and as a result our Parade Commander – Jesus Christ was born on earth in human form to be able to empathise with us and become our Saviour through his death and resurrection.

2025 has been a steady as we go year for the MCF as we continue to build and develop a widened vision to be more intentionally inclusive of families and veterans, we have continued to build the relationship with the other ministries

within Defence (FCMM) which has also brought many blessings, we have continued to decentralise and encourage the MCF Reps and groups to be more active in their regions rather than a Canberra centric focus

This Christmas season, if you like to donate to charity, why not consider a donation to MCF-A?



Thank you to those who already contribute and every \$ counts, so no donation is too small!



Book Review - Made in our image; God, artificial intelligence and you By Stephen Driscoll



Driscoll's book is a thoughtful and thorough look at Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its potential impact on the world as we know it. AI represents a considerable leap forward in technological advancement and Driscoll's realistic assessment notes that it is here to stay and will significantly impact our lives and how we work. He helpfully demystifies AI by explaining what it is and how it works, helping the reader to understand its tremendous benefits and limitations; its pitfalls and promises. Technological change is not new and like all technology before, we can be certain AI will be used for both good and evil, but resisting its influence on that basis is both unhelpful and unnecessary.

Driscoll steps logically though the issues, encouraging us to think biblically about the technology, its foundations and its application. Al can accomplish many tasks more accurately and more quickly than humans, but there are some things that remain the remit of humans uniquely made in God's image. He therefore encourages us to not be


unreasonably fearful of AI technology and the change it will bring, but nor should we blithely embrace it without critical thinking.

The growing application of AI and the social change it instigates makes Christianity and the message of the gospel more rather than less relevant. Driscoll insightfully describes how the presence of AI might shape Christian ministry and our unchanging message of the one true Saviour. I thoroughly recommend this book as a well-written and thoughtful reflection on this important issue facing the modern Christian.

A reappraisal of Romans 8–11 and Ephesians 1 in their first century context




Mark Warren, past MCF Area Rep and one time MCF Staffworker, has just had his Master of Theology dissertation published by Wipf & Stock.
