7 June 2026

- † In our scripture for this month, Jesus says in this world we will have trouble, but in Him we may have peace. Let us seek His divine peace when we face troubles.
- † Pray for those injured during their time in Defence. Pray for the families of ADF personnel who have recently lost their lives.
- † Thank God for the Joint Heads of Pacific Security (JHoPS) meeting held in the last week of April, where the heads of police, military, customs and immigration agencies from across the Pacific region met to discuss strategic priorities and advance Pacific-led responses to regional security challenges.
- † Pray that the MCF-A budget will be met for this financial year. Please consider helping the MCF-A financially so the budget can be met. 14 June 2026

- † Pray for those struggling financially. Pray that God will meet all their needs.
- † Praise God for Exercise Balikatan, which involved Australia, the Philippines, the United States, New Zealand, Canada, Japan and France. These nations worked together to enhance military cooperation and collective readiness, strengthen military-to-military ties and build on multinational interoperability.
- † Thank God for Exercise Bersama Shield, the latest combined joint training exercise conducted by the Five Power Defence Arrangements (FPDA) nations. In total, 1055 defence personnel from Australia, Malaysia, New Zealand, Singapore and the United Kingdom participated in this exercise.
- † Praise God for Exercise Pozieres March, which focused on how geostrategic competition and rapid advances in technology were changing how wars were fought. The Chief of Army, Lieutenant General Simon Stuart, said it was an opportunity to share lessons from

current conflicts and strengthen how partners operate together.

21 June 2026

- † Pray for those commencing new postings or changing roles in the new financial year, including those having to move houses, school or leave friends and family behind. Pray that those moving will soon find a new Church family as well as Christians in their workplace.
- † Praise God that Australia and PNG worked together to deliver critical humanitarian assistance to communities across PNG, following Tropical Cyclone Maila.
- † Thank God the Combined Space Operations (CSpO) Initiative Principals' Board met in the US to address the rapidly evolving security dynamics of the space domain. Senior representatives from Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, New Zealand, Norway, the United Kingdom, and the United States attended the meeting.

- † Praise God for the Bible Society Australia and its donors who help gift material for Defence personnel. Praise God for the new ADF Bibles and how well they are being received across Defence. Pray people will read these Bibles, they will be encouraged and changed, and they will bring people to Christ.

28 June 2026

- † Praise God that the Australian Defence Minister and New Zealand Defence Minister released the joint statement “*Operationalising our Alliance*”, which mentions a shared vision of operating seamlessly as an increasingly integrated, combat-capable Anzac force by 2035.
- † Thank God that Australian personnel on Operation Kudu are working with partner nations from Europe to deliver training to Ukrainian soldiers bound for the front line. Australians are embedded alongside forces from Finland, Lithuania, Kosovo, the Netherlands, Sweden,

Norway, the United Kingdom and Ukraine.

- † Thank God for the inquiry into the weaponisation of the military justice system, conducted by the Inspector-General of the ADF, Mr James Gaynor CSC. Defence will now consider the 20 recommendations made for a more effective, trusted and fairer military justice system.
- † Praise God that the RAAF has taken delivery of its 14th and final P-8A Poseidon aircraft. These aircraft will strengthen Australia's ability to conduct anti-submarine warfare, maritime strike, and intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance missions.
